Pine Rest's doctoral internship in professional psychology seeks to provide broad training in a practitioner-scholar program. The internship is housed in a large, comprehensive behavioral health system in beautiful West Michigan. Pine Rest has 198 licensed psychiatric beds for all ages, a psychiatric urgent care center, 173 residential beds, 17 interdisciplinary outpatient clinics, and an active research department collaborating with regional and national universities. Interns provide services across the continuum of care, including inpatient, outpatient, and residential services. Interns completing the program will be well-prepared for any number of psychology positions. Our graduates have joined hospital systems, completed various fellowships, taught at the university level, and opened private practices--to name a few. Finally, interns are treated as colleagues during the year, receiving excellent training from supervisors and staff who genuinely care for their professional and personal development.
