Information for submitters:

Abstracts should present empirical research findings. It can be on any topic relevant to the prevention or treatment of mood disorders and related conditions (i.e. depression, bipolar disorders, and suicide). Previously presented Abstracts are permitted.

- Abstract text is limited to 500 words, excluding title and authors, and must be written in English.
- Abstracts should clearly describe the objective/hypothesis, methods/approach, results, and conclusion.
- Abstracts should include a list of all authors with institution affiliations, as well as the presenting author indicated.
- Abstracts must include a statement disclosing any conflicts of interest, financial or otherwise.
- Indicate whether the presenting author is a student, fellow/clinician, or researcher.
- Size limit - If accepted, posters may be **no larger than 4' x 3'**.

Abstracts are reviewed by members of the Depression Summit Scientific Program Committee. Decisions on abstract acceptance and other recognitions will be final.

Prizes will be awarded for best posters presented at the Summit.

Abstracts should be submitted to DepressionSummit@Pinerest.org by April 1, 2019. Presenters will be notified of decisions no later than April 15, 2019.
