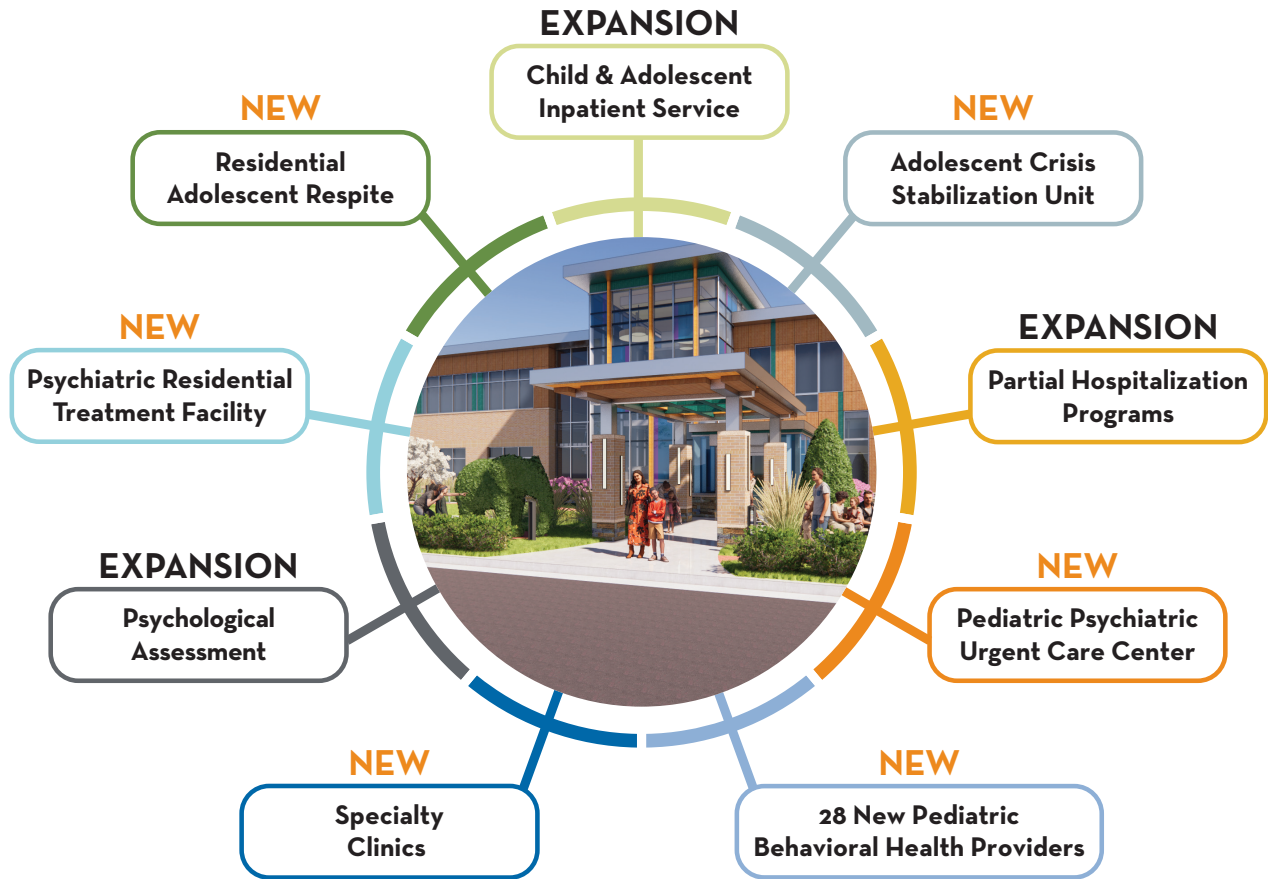


Pediatric Behavioral Health Center of Excellence

Concept Overview



The Pediatric Behavioral Health Center of Excellence will provide services for children and teens in one premiere facility, positively impacting Michigan families experiencing a pediatric behavioral health crisis both today and for generations to come. Located on Pine Rest’s 200-acre park-like campus, this multilevel, state-of-the-art facility will provide a warm, welcoming and supportive atmosphere for families.

Through the addition of new care models and the growth of existing services, the Center will expand access to inpatient care for an additional 3,000 children per year and to outpatient care to an additional 10,000 children each year.

Pine Rest is committed to addressing the gaps in care that most acutely affect Michigan’s children and will consult with healthcare organizations, community agencies, first responders, and affected families across the state to identify the programs and services of greatest need. Based on findings, specialty services will be tailored to remove barriers to access and meet the unique behavioral health care concerns of children and teens throughout Michigan.
